Buffalo Chicken Dip

Lasagne Aubergine

Macaroni and Cheese

Macaronis et Fromage de Langoustine

It just didn't seem quite right to name this decadent gastroconcoction in English. Here's our already world-famous Macaroni and Cheese prepared with Atlantic lobster and lump crab meat. \$18.13

Jamaican Tacos Tonight?

Yes. Yes we are. Three really spicy pulled jerk chicken tacos, Jamaican-style with some calming cilantro cream and pineapple-black bean salsa to bring the temperature down to a manageable level. \$14.99. With quinoa and some veggies on da side, mon!

Upstate Chicken Riggies

A favorite in all of New York (save for The City), this casserole is the stuff that brings grandmothers to fisticuffs in local contests. If you break it down you'll decipher that there's chicken and rigatoni pasta, plus what goes with that? Vodka sauce, cheese, peppers, mushrooms, and black olives, silly. \$14.42

Downstate "Chicken" Riggies

A favorite here in the Muppet Labs test kitchen, some 400 miles southwest of Utica. They're just like Upstate Chicken Riggies but made with local Parma Hot Italian Sausage instead of chicken. \$14.42 *Oinkus non cluck.*

Four-Cheese Bolognese

Local hand-made four-cheese ravioli from our friends at Fede Pasta, paired with a spicy sausage Bolognese sauce. \$14.46 Not feelin' the meat? We'll be happy to make a vegetarian version a la marinara - just ask.

What are you looking down here for?

Big Cowboy Ribeye

Saddle up, it's gonna be a long ride, pardner. One whopper of a prime rib cut, bone-in to retain flavor and moisture, grilled as you like it* and served with smashers and vegetable sidekicks. \$23.96 Caution: contains one bone.

Rita Hayworth and the Pork Shank Redemption

Our famous towering monstrosity of meat: fall-off-the-bone-tender braised pork finished with our Bourbon Glaze, set amidst a silky bed of horseradish smashers. \$18.71 Caution: contains two bones.

Paradise by the Dashboard Light

Certified Angus beef meatloaf cobbled up on a toast raft, with horseradish smashers and a rich and chunky mushroom gravy. \$15.27 We would do anything for love, but we wouldn't do that.

Fish Tacos!

Freshly folded and ready for lovin' come two soft tortillas filled with fish either grilled or fried (your choice - one or 'tuther) with some slaw, some quinoa, and the veggie du jour. \$15.99

Crab Cakes McArdle

Watching Deadliest Catch makes this dish all that more interesting, with people risking their lives by chain smoking on a boat to bring us the best crab in the Bering sea. Jumbo lumpers with quinoa and veg of the day, plus our special sauce Remoulade. \$21.44

Treacher Self to Fish & Chips

Nothing's more trendy than street food right now. We wrap up some delicately seasoned and fried Atlantic Cod in an old newspaper and serve it with our sauce Remoulade and fries that the Brits for some reason call "chips. They're weird. \$14.21 Sprinkling a little malt vinegar around really adds to the authenticity.

The Pen is Mightier than the Swordfish

Strangely, you can't farm-raise swordfish. Strange. Anyhow, we managed to spear a couple of these big guys and cut some nice thick half pound steaks that we grill nicely and swizzle with bright citrus glaze. \$0 Remember reading Ernest Hemmingway's "The Old Man And The Sea"? Yeah, that was a different kind of fish.

BURGHERS & SANDWICHES

Sandwiches and Burghers come with a little side salad or fries, or any other starch or veggie we felt like making. Substitute your little side salad here for a petite version of our Classic Greek salad for a minimal increase. Burghers are half a pound of Black Angus beef from happy, well adjusted cattle who came from good looking Lutheran families, grilled to your liking*. Vegetarians beware: one of these at your table could mess with your convictions. "Simple, bloody perfection" say the critics.

Delmonico a Go Go*

This is the steak sandwich that just might heal a thousand vegetarians. It's so much more than its diluted ancestor from Philly who's now served at gas stations. Four lithe sliders of BBQ Pork, prodded, poked, and pulled professionally on premises by our pork-pulling prep punks, presented with pickles and offered with onions, slaw on the side just along for the ride. \$9.84

I Can Has Bacon Cheezburger? *

Rich, smokehouse bacon and sharp, bitey cheddar atop a manhole cover of grilled beef that's more than able to satisfy even the most demanding carnivore. \$9.97 Put your feet up, kick back with a PBR, and cancel your gym membership.

Roethlisburger

Turkey Burgher
